Upgrading to the latest version of Blade File Transfer System

Obtaining the latest version of Blade File Transfer System

Download the latest Blade File Transfer System packaged installers from <http://www.blade.net.nz/Download> . The latest 32-bit and 64-bit installers for client and server software are available.



Upgrading your Blade File Transfer System servers

You do not need to uninstall an earlier version of Blade File Transfer System before upgrading. Follow these instructions to upgrade your servers:

1. To preserve your settings, back up your existing Web.config file (usually located in C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\BladeTS directory) by renaming it to Web.config.bak.
2. Run Setup.exe and install Blade File Transfer System 2.0.2 server by following the installation wizard.
3. Navigate to C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\BladeTS and delete the newly created Web.config file.
4. Rename Web.config.bak to Web.config.



Upgrading client computers

You do not need to uninstall an earlier version of Blade File Transfer System before upgrading the client computers. Simply run the **Blade Client Setup.msi** installer and install Blade File Transfer System Client by following the installation wizard. All your existing settings, including the product key will be preserved.
